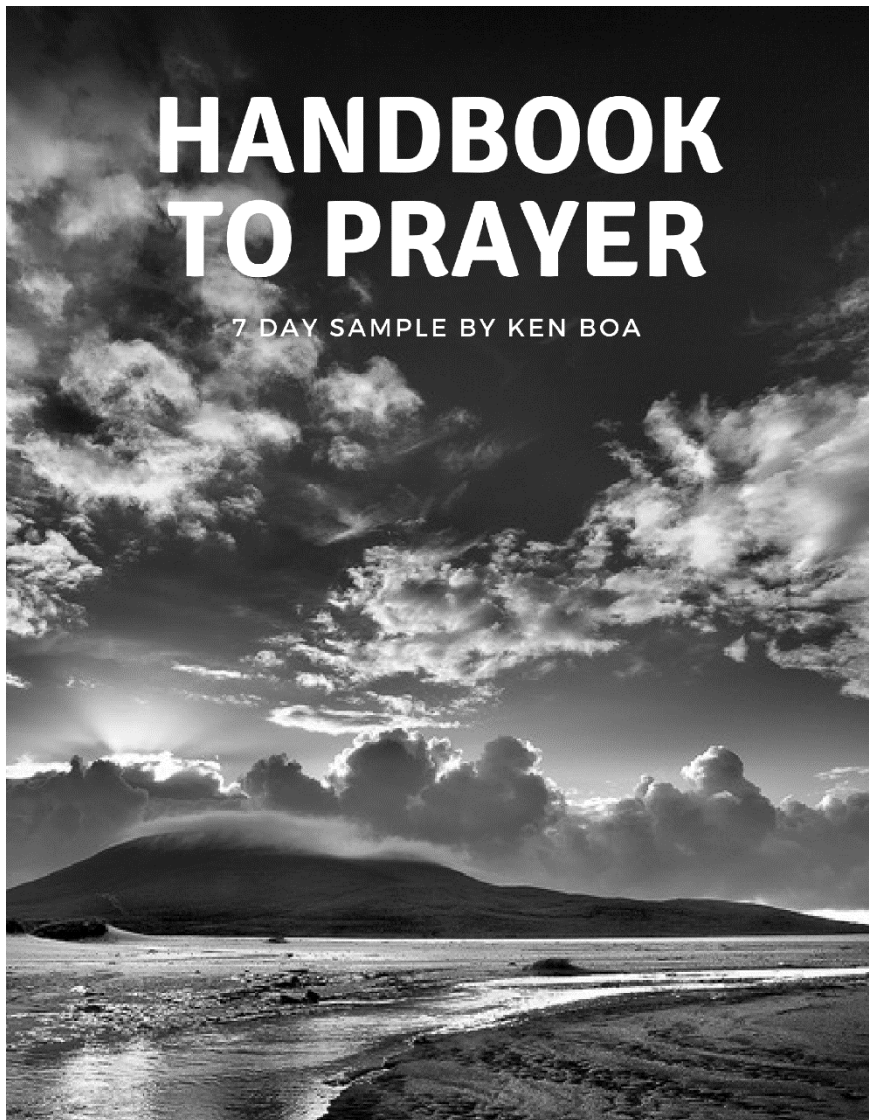


HANDBOOK TO PRAYER

Day 1

Adoration

O LORD, our Lord,

how majestic is your name in all the earth!

You have set your glory above the heavens. Psalm 8:1

³And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying,
“Great and amazing are your deeds,

O Lord God the Almighty!

Just and true are your ways,

O King of the nations!

⁴Who will not fear, O Lord,

and glorify your name?

For you alone are holy.

All nations will come

and worship you,

for your righteous acts have been revealed.” Revelation 15:3-4

Pause to express your thoughts of praise and worship.

Confession

⁴The LORD is in his holy temple;

the LORD's throne is in heaven;

his eyes see, his eyelids test the children of man. Psalm 11:4

Ask the Spirit to search your heart and reveal any areas of unconfessed sin. Acknowledge these to the Lord and thank Him for His forgiveness.

Renewal

¹²“And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, Deuteronomy 10:12

Adoration

Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? Hebrews 12:7-9
